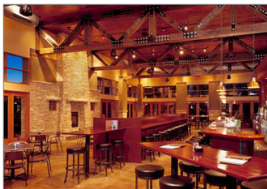

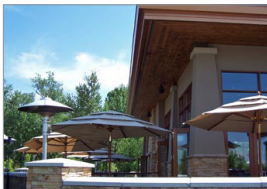

Housed in unpretentious surroundings, The Bardenay Restaurant and Distillery offers a unique combination of handcrafted spirits and quality cocktails with a diverse menu. This establishment in Eagle, Idaho is located along the greenbelt path on the Boise River, influencing our design which incorporates cultured stone and wood siding with a shake roof to blend well with the natural river bank. Operable glass Nana walls provide excellent natural lighting and extraordinary river views from within. A vertical glass encased distiller is one of the main architectural features on display. The design also features an extensive outdoor patio dining area that is oriented toward the river and features stained concrete with wrought iron railings to utilize the natural river landscaping.



The Bardenay was honored with the first annual Golden Eagle Award from the City of Eagle for outstanding building design.



BRS has also site adapted the Eagle design for another Bardenay restaurant located in Coeur d' Alene, Idaho. Located along the edge of a small man made lake, the design also utilizes the cultured stone and wood siding with a shake roof along with the Nana walls that open to large stamped concrete patios.
